This land was originally settled by Keen and Anna Lewis Field. Then it was occupied by Keen's son Abraham and wife Grace Rainey Field. Then by a grandson Benjamin R. Field and Lydia Ellen Brown. It has been owned since by a Miller, Homer Morrison and Fred and John Anthis.

The railroad runs though the property and at times was known as Fields Station and Miller Station.
