Susan Wright graduated from Nappanee High School in 1954, and from Indiana University, in 1958, with a BS Degree in Elementary Education. Since her marriage she has lived in Baghdad, Iraq; Paris, France; Bengahzi, Libya; Port of Spain, Trinidad; Abidjan, Ivory Coast; and at the present (Feb. 1967) is scheduled to go to Lome, Togo this year. Lyle's diplomatic service requires him to spend two years at a post and then have home leave. However, he can be specially assigned to a post before the two year stint is completed, as in this latest assignment. Home leave is usually for a period of 6 to 8 weeks. They served their first assignment in Baghdad, Iraq, during the revolution in 1958. Six weeks after Susan arrived she was flown out by the government for the duration of the revolution, first to Rome, Italy. Later she went to Amsterdam, Holland, to be near Lyle's brother who was teaching on a Fullbright Scholarship. Lyle's family, on his father's side, are in the Netherlands, and aunt Marie van Hengle at the Hague, and aunt Cornelia Gielings as Wassanaar. In Feb. 1959, Susan returned to Iraq when it was considered safe for dependents to return. She flew to Beirut, Lebanon, shortly before Lisa was born at the American Hospital-Hospital facilities at Baghdad were inadequate.
