1. Jonathan* MOSSHOLDER¹ was born in 1750 in Germany,¹ died in 1813 in Pennsylvania² at age 63, and was buried in 1813 in Joe Croner Farm At Mineral Springs, Brothers Valley Twp., Somerset County, Pennsylvania Near Berlin.¹

General Notes: He was the first Mossholder to come to America and is a Rev. War Vet. Th is line has been proven and most Mossholder's in the U.S. are descendan ts of John & Johanna. Mickie Parr, mickieparr@hotmail.com

Noted events in his life were:

- Immigration: from Germany, 9 November 1767, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania.³ Johathan Mossholder arrived in Philadelphia on 9 November 1767 on the ship Minerva. The ship originated in Rotterdam, the Netherlands. Upon landing in Philadelphia, he took an oath of allegiance to the king of England with his fellow passergers. He is listed as Joh. Masshalder in the list of oath takers. (The date of the oath has been recorded as 29 October 1767, in Philidelphia. This is actualy prior to the date the ship is recorded as arriving. This is a discrepancy.)
- Military: Served in the American Revolutionary War. Private Second Class, 5th Company Battalion, 8th Battalion and 4th Battalion, Cumberland County, Militia., 1777 - August 16, 1780.⁴

Jonathan* married **Johanna* STUMP**,⁵ daughter of **Adam STUMP** and **Isabella**, in Pennsylvania.⁶ Johanna* died before 1800 in Joe Croner Farm At Mineral Springs, Brothers Valley Twp., Somerset County, Pennsylvania Near Berlin.⁷

Jacob* married **Dinah* Christina FRITZ**,¹¹ daughter of **Christian* William FRITZ** and **Eva* Margaret DORWARTON**, from 1798 to 1799 in Somerset County, Pennsylvania.¹¹ Dinah* was born on 10 April 1779 in New Hanover Twp., Montgomery County, Pennsylvania,¹¹ died on 14 April 1847 in Stonycreek Creek Twp., Somerset County, Pennsylvania¹¹ at age 68, and was buried in 1847 in Friedens Lutheran Cemetery, Somerset County, Pennsylvania.¹¹

Marriage Notes: Harold Weigle states in his Ancestors of Lydia Mosholder, that they were married in Brothersvalley Twp., Somerset County, Pennsylvania, and uses Mosholder Descendants by Geraldine Mosholder as his source but gives no page number. No reference to the place of marriage is listed in the Mosholder Descendant book.¹³

General Notes: The Gohn book says John and Lydia had two sons that died in the Civil War. It is possible these were Daniel and Samuel. They would have been just of age at the very end of the War.

May have died in 1888. Miriam Grasz visited the cemetery in Shipshewan a, Indiana in Oct. 1972. [The death date may have been quite worn.]



Pearl's biological father was John Ferguson. Her biological mother was Clara Gohn. Pearl was raised by her great-aunt and great-uncle, Mary (Polly) (Gohn) and John J. Poynter. Mary was Chauncey Gohn's sister, and also Isabelle Allison's sister. I don't know if she was ever legally adopted by the Poynter's. Her marriage license said "foster daughter of" John and Mary Poynter. I don't think Pearl knew Clara was her mother until she was a teenager. Her diary often says "got a letter from Clara" or "a card from Clara". In this diary Pearl also refers to the Poynter's as "Ma" and "Pa". Now, if you can keep all that straight, I'll give you a medal! Ha!

In the 1900 census for Shipshewana, living with John and Mary Poynter was Flossie Pearl Ferguson. However, in the 1910 census, she was Pearl Poynter. When that all changed is lost in time.
