

One other son was born to them in 1910, Paul Eugene, who died as an infant. They also had a daughter, Roxie Geneva who was born in 1904 and died in 1912. Charles was married to Elizabeth M. Heeter, 18 December 1892 and they had one daughter Blanch Pearl Kiste in 1897. The parents of Charles were Jacob Kiste (1842-1925) and Catherine Cramer (1844-1925). Fannie's parents were John Benjamin Wilson (1823-1903) and Susannah Barbara Adams (1840-1920).
